Things to consider when designing your bookmark

- Keep it simple
- Think about your color choices. Can you read the text?
- Does your graphic relate to your message/quote?
- Is the text and graphic balanced on your bookmark? Neither one is too big or too small.
- Be creative!



Bookmark Requirements

- Use <u>Canva</u> to create an original design (do not use a template)
- **Background**--Include a background color or design
- **Text**--Message or quote about reading

- Elements--A graphic relating to the text
